Human migration is taking place all over the world as wars, political upheaval, climate change, terrorism, trafficking, and extreme poverty displace people or make survival in one's home region tenuous. As we have seen from anthropology and new DNA based ancestry analysis, global migration has been happening since the beginning of humankind. It has always shaped communities, economies and cultures. What is rarely discussed are the different categories of migrants and the legal systems that protect both local communities and migrants themselves.

Selin Yildiz Nielsen, Co-founder and President of Glocally Connected, has worked in international education at undergraduate and postgraduate levels for the last 20 years as a director, professor, coordinator, manager, instructor, and consultant in California, Iowa, Washington D.C., and the Republic of Turkey. Dr. Yildiz Nielsen's work with refugees started in a non-profit organization dedicated to facilitating migrant and refugee integration in Iowa. She has also led projects providing educational assistance to teachers in Syrian refugee camps in Southeast Turkey during her time as a visiting professor in the region.
