As a record number of migrants cross the Mediterranean Sea to find asylum in Europe, the continent is struggling to come up with an adequate response. Although Europe’s refugees are largely fleeing conflicts in Syria, Iraq and parts of Africa, their struggle is hardly unique. Today, with the number of displaced people at an all-time high, a number of world powers find themselves facing a difficult question of how to respond. As political leaders in America and Europe struggle to meet the Syrian migration crisis, it has become a hot topic in the US presidential campaign. We will learn about and discuss the issues around migration and our policy options.
